
Dear Parents/Guardians

Below are the details for the 3-6 Swimming Carnival. Please note that **Friday 31 January 2020** is the cut-off date for nominations of events and parent helpers.

Attendance/Participation	Attendance is compulsory. Non-attendance without explanation will be noted. Maximum participation by all students is our aim for the carnival. There is opportunity for all students to contribute to House points throughout the program.

Venue	Cooma Swimming Pool	
Date	Tuesday 4 February 2020	
Cost	\$3.70 pool entry on the day, unless students have a season pass. This is to be shown on entry to the pool. No money is required for season ticket holders. Pool entry for ALL SPECTATORS, INCLUDING PARENTS VOLUNTEERING AS TIME KEEPERS is \$3.40.	
Time of Carnival and Dismissal from the Pool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The carnival is expected to begin at 9.40am. Parents are reminded that the carnival does not conclude until 2.45pm and therefore students travelling via private transport are not to be collected until that time. • At the end of the carnival students must either return to school or go home with a parent/carer. Parents will need to see the classroom teacher at the conclusion of the carnival before departing with their child. No student will be allowed to leave the pool without an adult or remain at the pool without their parent being present. Parent's co-operation in this matter is greatly appreciated. 	
Dress Code	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students may wear appropriate House coloured clothing to and from the carnival OR students may change into House colours at the carnival. Please also bring a hat and sunscreen as well as warm clothing on the day, if the weather is cool. NO COLOURED ZINC, CREPE PAPER OR HAIRSPRAY. • It is requested that female students wear one piece swimmers. Bikini tops are not permitted at any time during the carnival. 	
Transportation	Students are to come to school for normal roll call. They will then be accompanied by their teacher to walk to the pool in class groups. Students will be back at school in time for their normal school buses.	
Canteen and Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The pool canteen will be open all day. Parents having lunch with their children are asked to sit in the area of your child's House colour. Students will be able to purchase food from the canteen throughout the day. 	
Nominations for Events on Carnival Day	All parents/carers for each child are requested to complete the nomination for events slip by Friday 31 January .	
Swimming Caps	Students can choose to wear swimming caps however they are not compulsory to wear. The school will not be providing swim caps this year.

Age Champion Points	Students are awarded points based on where they finish in their age group for a particular stroke and distance. The student with the highest points at the end of the carnival is our age champion. If there is a tie both students will be crowned age champion. There are no individual points awarded in relays or novelty events. 100m and 50m events (all strokes): 1 st – 10pt, 2 nd – 8pt, 3 rd – 6 pt, 4 th – 4pt 25m events (all strokes): 1 st – 5pt, 2 nd – 4pt, 3 rd – 3pt, 4 th – 2pt STUDENTS CANNOT SWIM IN A 50M AND 25M EVENT OF THE SAME STROKE. 25m events don't count towards individual age championship points, only 50m and 100m events count.	
Presentation	House Results and Age Champions will be announced at the conclusion of the carnival. Certificates for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd place getters will be presented at a school morning assembly shortly after the carnival. A copy of age championship results and records broken will be published in the newsletter.	
Representation	A representative team will be chosen based on the results of 50m, 100m and 200m IM events. This team will represent St Patrick's at the Catholic Schools Southern Region Carnival at Narooma on Wednesday 19 February. Notes will be handed out at school to students who have qualified for the Southern Region carnival.	
Helpers	To enable the carnival to run efficiently, some parental help is required. If you are able to assist as a timekeeper/helper on the day, it would be greatly appreciated.
